SUMMER TERM REMINDERS

Attendance:

As we begin the last term of the school year, it is ever more important that school attendance is a priority. We all know the impact that missed school days can have and supporting your child by ensuring their attendance every day is one way of providing them with the best possible chance to learn, develop and be successful. Research shows that children who have good attendance are more likely to academically succeed at all levels.

Uniform:

As we are now in the Summer Term, children may wear summer uniform if they choose. I have copied the uniform expectations below. This term we will be reminding all children of expectations and Class Teachers will be contacting parents where children are not wearing the correct uniform so that we can identify and overcome any barriers. All children are expected to always wear the correct full uniform, including on PE days, unless a specific exception has been agreed on medical or SEND grounds.

High quality pre-loved items (and some new shorts/summer dresses for ages 8+) will be available at the school office this week. This is the FLS uniform stock and is sold for a donation (suggestion of £1 per item). There are trousers, dresses, jumpers and cardigans. A few PE shirts, sports items and white polos are also available. If anyone has any outgrown uniform, we are always grateful for donations too.

At Laburnum we want our children to be proud of themselves and their school and we believe that wearing uniform is an important part of this. Please make sure that ALL items of clothing are **clearly labelled** with your child's name.

Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and 2

- Grey shorts/ trousers/ skirt or pinafore dress
- **White polo shirt - plain or with school logo**
- School jumper or cardigan with school logo
- Sensible black shoes (not trainers)
- Grey socks or tights

In the Summer navy blue and white checked gingham dresses may be worn

PE and Sports Kit

Nursery

- **No** PE kit required.

Reception - Year 6

- School sports shirt (navy and red) with school logo,
- Navy shorts or jogging bottoms,
- Plimsolls or trainers.
- School jumpers, fleeces or plain navy-blue jumpers may also be worn on PE days.

If your child does not have a plain navy-blue jumper or a school fleece, they must wear a school jumper or cardigan (which all children have) – no alternative sports tops or hoodies will be accepted, and your child will be provided with an alternative to wear for the day.

Year 3-6

Grey shorts/ trousers/ skirt or pinafore dress

- **Plain white shirt and school tie**
- School jumper or cardigan with school logo
- Sensible black shoes (not trainers)
- Grey socks or tights

In the Summer navy blue and white checked gingham dresses may be worn

Health and Safety

- For safety reasons we ask that children do not wear jewellery in school. If your child has pierced ears, then please make sure that they only wear studs in school.
- A child may wear a watch, but the school cannot accept responsibility for it.
- Long hair should be tied back with red or navy bands.
