STUDYBUGS - ATTENDANCE

Thank you for the feedback that you have provided regarding Study Bugs. Most parents really appreciate being able to provide simple updates through the app, but we realise that this is not always the best way to communicate. The app has been really helpful in most cases, but if you feel that you need to communicate in person, please do phone the school office and explain your child's absence that way.

I have also asked Study Bugs to pause their communication to parents in relation to the trigger points (97%, 92% and 90%) as we don't feel that the wording of these is right yet and this has also been fed back by some parents. I hope that Laburnum families know that as a school we work hard to build positive relationships with children and their parents/carers and any offence caused by attendance messages is unintentional. We will resume sending very soon when we have had time to reword in a way that we feel is more appropriate and reflective of Laburnum and the relationship we have with you as parents/carers.

SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

When we work closely with families to provide additional support, this often falls under the heading of 'Early Help', where an assessment of need takes place and actions are identified for school, parents and other services. This is always done with your child as the central focus and usually results in improvements in the identified areas. Mr Bardell, Mrs Dawes and Mrs Boyall are our school safeguarding team that lead on Early Help and Safeguarding across the school. As Mrs Boyall is taking a leave of absence and to provide additional capacity for Mr Bardell and Mrs Dawes to support SEND across the school, we have appointed a temporary Early Help and Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead. This role will be undertaken by Mrs Annie Bardell, who many of you will be familiar with as she has taught several classes, most recently Beech Class and also provides additional small group tuition for pupils in Years 1-3. Mrs Bardell will lead on almost all Early Help Assessments (EHAs) and many aspects of safeguarding.
