

MESSAGES, FEEDBACK AND REFLECTIONS FROM THE HEAD

It has been a really productive week in school again, with fantastic behaviour in classrooms and a positive attitude to learning. Starting next week, the next 2 months are when formal assessments are completed. Year 6 have their end of Key Stage 2 SATs to complete – an opportunity to demonstrate their learning and progress. After half term, the Year 4 Multiplication check and Year 1 Phonics check are completed. We are so proud of the progress our children have made with Phonics and Multiplication and practise assessments show that the majority of pupils have mastered most of these skills already, with daily practice supporting all children to achieve. All other years will also complete formal and informal assessments to support the judgements teachers make towards the end of the year. Assessment outcomes will be shared in the end of year pupil reports.

As we progress through the year, it is ever more important that the children do not miss any days of school if at all possible as every day in school brings learning opportunities and the chance to practice and consolidate knowledge and skills.

ROAD SAFETY

We had a phone call yesterday about a near miss with 2 of our pupils who were going home on their own on scooters. It is likely that this was pupils from Year 5 or Year 6, but I would ask that all parents remind their children about safety on scooters, bikes and when walking to and from school, whether with an adult or not.

YEAR 3 CAMP

Most parents will be aware of our programme of overnight visits. This starts in Year 3 with a one-night stay on the school field. Today, we have sent home 24 exhausted Year 3 children who will have lots of experiences to share with their families. The Year 3 camp is a fun-filled, energetic and supportive experience, where all children are challenged in different ways. Below are a few photographs from last night.

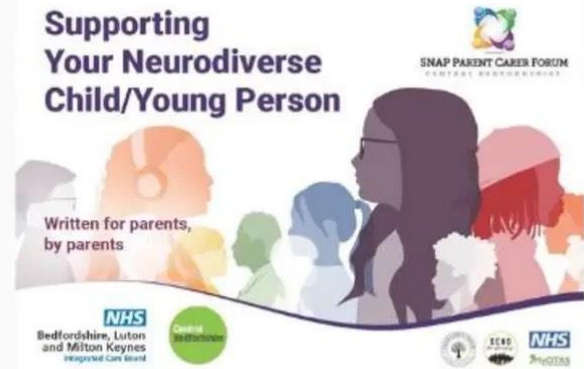
